The screening begins at 11.30 p.m., with a pre-party kicking off at 10.30 p.m.

Long a favourite of late-night film-goers, Rocky Horror Picture Show was released in 1975 – and almost immediately became a cult classic. It stars Susan Sarandon (Janet) and Barry Bostwick (Brad) as newlyweds who are stranded when their car breaks down. They seek refuge at the castle of Dr. Frank 'N Furter (Tim Curry), a mad scientist from the planet Transsexual.

Brad and Janet arrive on the special night that Dr. Furter's beautiful creature, Rocky – the Adonis humanoid created for the release of Frank's "tension" – is to be born. What follows is action-packed romance, Transylvanian parties, thrills and chills, lots of laughs – and 16 great songs, including The Time Warp, Sweet
